



TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

The following Terms of the Competition apply for all Professional Junior Challenge tournament in line with the Rules of Golf as published by R&A Rules Limited organized by Sirkit Golf Remaja Kedah (SGRK).

1. MANAGEMENT

The inaugural Professional & Junior Challenge (hereinafter referred to as "The Competition") shall be managed by a Tournament Committee (hereinafter referred to as "The Committee") whose decisions in all matters relating to the Competition shall be final.

2. VENUE AND DATES

The Competition will be played at **Bukit Beruntung Golf & Country Club, Lot 1994, Bandar Bukit Berutung, 48300 Rawang, Selangor** hereinafter referred to "BBGCR") from the **29**th **to 30**th **March, 2022.**

3. ELIGIBILITY

3.1 The Competition is open to male and female players who are:

- a. Open to all PGAM members.
- b. A junior golfer in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by R&A between the age of 13 to 21 years old boys and girls on or before the first day of the competition.
- c. Having a maximum valid handicap index of 18 for Boys and Girls.
- d. The Tournament Committee has the rights to determine players' handicap based on submission during registration to be confirmed by members' club(s) and/or verified through peer review.

3.2 COVID19 DECLARATION

- a. Fully vaccinated status (MySejahtera apps)
- b. Submit current RTK result during registration day on the 28th March.

The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry without giving any reason whatsoever.

4. FORMAT OF PLAY

The Competition shall be decided by gross stroke play over two round of 18 holes for the Professionals and the Juniors. The field will be limited to 120 participants on first come first serve basis. The Competition will be played from the Black teeing area for the Professionals,

Blue teeing area for the boys and Red teeing area for the girls. Players will be in a group of four and PGAM and SGRK reserves the right to assign the draw pairing.

There will be six competitions in one.

- i. Professional
- ii. Junior boy 13 to 16
- iii. Junior girl 13 to 16
- iv. Junior boy 17 to 21
- v. Junior girl 17 to 21
- vi. Partnership (Four ball best ball, the partnership will be determined by draw lot)

The lowest gross score for each category on both rounds is the winner.

The professional has an obligation to compete 36 holes with their partners disregard their position in the field. Failure to do so will result a disciplinary action taken against the player by the Tournament Committee.

5. SCHEDULE OF PLAY

6. ENTRY AND CLOSING DATE

All entry is to be made online at http://www.golfremajakedah.com

The official online entry form and must reach the Tournament Secretariat latest by 5:00pm on Friday, 25th March 2022. Please check with Tournament Secretariat for your entry status. The participant is always responsible to ensure his entry has been received by the SGRK Tournament Secretariat.

Entry must be accompanied with a non-refundable entry fee of MYR\$290 for the professional and MYR\$350 for the junior.

A receipt will be issued upon payment within 4 working days and will be required as proof of payment during registration on unofficial practice day (before the competition commences).

7. WITHDRAWAL

7.1 Pre-Tournament

All withdrawal must be done via email to Tournament Secretariat with reason stating of withdrawal.

7.2 During Tournament

A competitor is entitled to withdraw from a tournament for medical reasons **ONLY** provided he informs the Tournament Director before close of play each day. Written evidence of medical circumstances must be immediately forwarded. Withdrawal without consent or approval from Tournament Director will result the competitor will be banned for playing in future tournaments.

8. RULES OF PLAY

Players must comply with the Rules of Golf as amended by Local Rules in force at any event and further comply with Terms of Competition as approved and published by the Committee.

9. PRACTISE - RULE 5

a. Practise before or between rounds - Rule 5.2b

Rule 5.2b is modified in this way:

A player must not practice on the competition course before or between rounds.

Penalty for breach of Rule – see penalty statement in Rule 5.2

b. Practise on or near previous putting green prohibited - Rule 5.5b Rule 5.5b is modified in this way:

Between the play of two holes, a plyer must not:

Make any penalty strokes on or near the putting green of the hole just completed, or Test the surface of the putting green by rubbing the putting green or rolling the ball.

10. TRANSPORT

Players are allowed to ride on the buggy.

11. PACE OF PLAY POLICY - RULE 5.6b

The attention of all competitors is drawn to Rule 5-6b, the competitor shall play without undue delay. In the interest of fair play the Tournament Committee will not hesitate to impose the penalties provided by that Rule. The maximum time allotted for the completion of 18 holes is to be determined by the Tournament Committee. (Please see the Tournament Notice Board).

The following conditions shall apply if a group is observed to be out of position, i.e. it has lost substantially more than its starting interval or in the case of the first flight has taken in the opinion of the Rules Official / Chief Referee / Tournament Director; an unacceptable amount of time to play any part of the golf course, the following action will be taken.

The group is liable to be timed without warning. (Individual clocking)

From the commencement of any timing, if any player exceeds 50 seconds on a "first to play shot" or 40 seconds if it is a "second or third to play shot" he shall be deemed to have had a "bad time".

Penalty for breach of Rule 5.6b:

a. One bad time - Warning from official and told that if he/she has

a further bad time he/she will be penalized

b. Two bad times - One stroke penalty

c. Three bad times - Further penalty of two strokes

d. Four bad times - Disqualification

A player whose group is timed will have a bad time carried forward in the round even if the group subsequently arrives back in position or within time as may be specified by the Rules Official / Chief Referee / Tournament Director.

12. RETURN OF SCORECARD

All players must submit their scorecards duly signed and verified by his/her marker as soon possible not later than 10 minutes after the completion of their round. A scorecard is deemed to be submitted as soon as the player leaves the scoring area with both feet.

13. PRIZES & AWARDS

i. The total prize money for the professional tournament is RM20,000. In the event of a tie for the first place, the players tying shall as soon as possible continue to play-off until the winner is decided. In the event of a tie for any other placings below, the prize monies for such places shall be added together and divided equally amongst those tying. All prize money is subject to a PGAM levy of 5%.

- ii. Top 3 winners in each Junior categories and will receive medal.
- iii. Top 3 winners will get prizes for the partnership category.

Hi-Tea and prize awards ceremony will be immediately after the game. (Please see Tournament Notice Board for time and venue).

Note:

It is compulsory for all participants attending the awards ceremony.

Dress code: Golf attire or smart casual (Short pants, t-shirt with no collar and slippers are not allowed)

14. DECIDING TIES

- i. In deciding of a tie for the Professional and Junior 1st placing, hole by hole play-off until the winner is decided.
- ii. In deciding of a tie for any placing in the partnership including the 1st place, the tie shall be decided on count back by matching of scorecards in the following order:

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Last 18 holes (Hole 1 – 18)

Last 9 holes (Hole 10 – 18)

Last 6 holes (Hole 13 – 18)

Last 3 holes (Hole 16 – 18) and finally,

The last hole (Hole 18)
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15. DISPUTES, APPEAL AND DECISIONS

If the Committee has appointed a Referee, his/her decision is final (Rule 20.2a). In the absence of a Referee, any doubtful point on the Rules shall be referred to the Committee. Dispute arises during the Competition must be put forward to the Committee as soon as practicable not later than 15 minutes after completion of his/her round. The Committee decision shall be final (Rule 20.2b).

16. COMPETITION CLOSED

The Competition is closed when the results of the competition is officially announced and posted on the notice board.

17. INCLEMENT WEATHER AND SUSPENSION OF PLAY

The Committee will make every effort to complete the competition in its entirety. However, the Committee reserves the right to suspend and/or abandon play as and when necessary if weather related circumstances require such action. The Committee will inform the players accordingly.

18. INSURANCE / INDEMNITY / LIABILITIES

All participants are advice to have their own valid insurance coverage. SGRK, (golf club), the Sponsors, the Tournament Committee and their employees will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or harm, or any form of injuries that the players may suffer as a result of their participation in this competition.
